Anticipation is growing for the 2025 Coshocton County Fair. Young people in 4-H and FFA are working hard to prepare their animal projects for the shows and exhibitor sale that will take place at the end of the fair week on October 2. In 2024 the Junior Fair Auction sold 349 animal projects with a total dollar amount exceeding \$500,000. Needless to say, this is an important event in the community and specifically for these young folks.

The “Friends of the Coshocton County Junior Fair Auction” began in 2019 and commitment remains unchanged. We strive to **establish a financial pool of funds to make animal purchases and “add-on” to those with lower-than-average sale price.** At last year’s fair our group was able to contribute about \$10,000 to 40 kids who sold their animal projects.

We understand that livestock sales can sometimes be confusing and intimidating to those unfamiliar with the process. If you would like to support these kids without bidding “in person”, the “Friends of the . . . Auction” is a way to make that happen.

Some individuals and families who had children participate, in their younger days, see this as an opportunity to payback the generosity of their buyers. The deadline to receive the contributions is **September 23.**
